# Men's Member-Member Golf Tournament

## **General Information**

The Men's Member-Member is a 3 day 2-man team event. Teams will be placed in flights by the total of their combined indexes.

**Tees:** Teams have the option registering to play from the Tournament, Club, or Medal Tees. All will play a **54 hole** event over the three days.

**Registration:** A \$90 + tax entry fee will be charged to each player's account. The entry fee covers team prizes, daily prizes, beverages at the scoreboard each day and lunch on Sunday. Register by March 11 online via the club events calendar or fill out an entry card in any of the golf shops.

**Prizes:** The 3 teams in each flight with the lowest 54-hole total will have money posted to the Club's Credit Book.

**Daily prizes:** Will be awarded at the scoreboard to the team with the lowest score in each flight each day. Ties for the daily prize will be decided by a chip-off. Teams in contention are asked to remain near the scoreboard.

## FRIDAY, MARCH 18

### COURSES—DC/MW/PL 9AM SG

**Net Better Ball** - each partner plays his own ball. The lower net score is the score for the hole. Net scores are determined by subtracting handicap strokes, which are denoted on the scorecard, from the gross score on each hole. If one partner fails to complete the hole, there is no penalty. Handicaps are at 90%.

## SATURDAY, MARCH 19

### COURSES—DC/MW/PL 9AM SG

**Two-Man Scramble** - each player hits from tee. A minimum of **4 tee shots** from each person must be used. Once the drive is selected, both will hit their next shot from that position and repeat the process until the ball is holed. All lies may be improved within one club length (a putter head on the green) of the original position no nearer the hole. If the ball selected for play is located in a hazard, bunker, rough or fringe of the green, the ball must be played within one club length of the original position no nearer the hole, and must remain in the hazard, bunker, rough or fringe of the green. Handicaps are formulated by adding 35% of the A player's course handicap to 15% of the B player's course handicap.

## SUNDAY, MARCH 20

### COURSES—DC/MW/PL 9AM SG

1:15pm Lunch & Awards Ceremony at each course following play  
**Modified Scotch** – Each partner plays from the teeing ground and each plays his partner's ball for the second shot. After the second shot, partners select the ball with which they wish to score, and play that ball alternately to complete the hole. The partner whose second shot was not selected must play the third shot.

### Penalty shots do not affect the order of play

Handicap Allowance: The player with the lower course handicap is allowed 60% of his course handicap. The player with the higher course handicap is allowed 40% of his course handicap. The total is rounded off with fractions of .5 or more rounded upward. The total team handicap is denoted on the scorecard and shall be deducted from the team's total score.
